Results of descriptive statistics have been listed in Table2. Results have shown that all of the items have been positive and significant. Table2 presents students' perception domain of the English course e-Learning. Detailed information about items (1-7) of the questionnaire will be presented below.

Item 1: Most of respondents 31 (34.44%) strongly agree and 20 (22.22%) agree concluded that courses are beneficial, in addition to 15 (16.67%) disagreed, however, 8 (8.89%) strongly disagreed. The average value has been (3.57) of courses are useful.

Item 2: It showed that respondents of 32 (35.56%) strongly agree and 20 (22.22%) agree that study text-book guides in the building of my English skill, whereas 10 (11.11%) strongly disagreed. The average value of this item has been estimated as (3.56).

Item 3: 20 (30.00%) of the respondents said (agree) that Lecture notes are available for all of the lessons that have been given on English. And some of them around 16 (17.78%) said (strongly agree). But, 14 (15.56%) of the participants strongly disagreed. Total mean value of this item has been (3.12).

Item 4: It is observed that 27 (30.00%) said strongly agree and same rete agree that Lecture notes have simplified difficult lessons in English. Then only one (1.11%) of respondents have strongly disagreed. This item's mean is (3.61).

Item5: As observed 30 (33.33%) of respondents have stated that they strongly agree. Then around 25 (27.78%) of respondents were agree. While 7 (7.78%) have strongly disagreed. Mean of the item was (3.68).

Item 6: It has shown that participants of 29 (32.22%) strongly agree and 20 (22.22%) agree that study text-book contained practical-oriented exercises and projects in English skill. And 7 (7.78%) have strongly disagreed. This item's mean is (3.47).

Item 7: 28 (31.11%) of the respondents said (agree) the lecture notes provide connection between English and my programming lessons. And some of them about 21

(23.33%) have been undecided. However, 6 (6.67%) of the respondents have strongly disagreed. Total average value of this item is (3.62).

4. CONCLUSION

Courseware represents an effective and significant teaching and learning model, and it is at the core of the process of creating e-learning. This paper this argues that, since courseware quality is one of the factors for successfully implementing of e learning. This work had measured the responses of students at Technical Management Institute and have discovered that the quality of the Courseware needs to be studied as an important factor in e learning.
